PCA NSW State Camp was held from Sunday 9 to Friday 14 January at the Sydney International Equestrian Centre. Considering this was my fifth consecutive camp I was surprisingly nervous, mainly because there was a major difference this year. Instead of going for mounted games (like the previous 4 years) I was accepted for eventing which is my next favourite discipline after games. Penny was in the mounted games squad for the second year and it was very odd to not be in the same group with her. The first day, my group of 5 riders had a dressage and show jumping lesson with Sam Lyle who was to be our instructor for the week. Jed was a little unsettled in the indoor arena but after the softening exercises he soon lost the tenseness. Tuesday was much the same, though we did get to do a proper round of show jumping as opposed to lots of poles and balancing exercises. Wednesday & Thursday were by far my favourite days as we went on the cross country course for a total of 3 hours, training over a variety of jumps from big & scary to tricky & technical.

All in all camp was fantastic. I learnt a lot during the riding instruction & made sure to take advantage of my time with Sam Lyle. The non-horse activities gave us a chance to get to know the other riders from other disciplines. I would definitely recommend state camp to anyone wishing to be a competitive rider as I had a fantastic time learning so much & making many new friends.
