Boots:

The three rally day rule

PCA NSW (state) and Zone 16 (zone) have qualification rules for state and zone events. Put simply, the rule is you must attend three (3) rally days in any twelve (12) month period in order to satisfy the qualification rules to be able to ride at a state championship, state camp or state school and likewise the same rule applies in Zone 16 to zone events.

This rule exists to ensure that riders and their mounts at state and zone events have been assessed by senior or chief instructors and are deemed to be of a suitable standard, especially for state championships. At a zone level, this rule ensures that riders maintain a connection to their club as well as being known to the club instructors.

The state office of PCA NSW has recently issued the following clarification on the rule.

“To enter in state PC championship events, the horse and rider combination must attend three working rallies of a pony club, in the previous twelve (12) months, two of which must have been at the Club which they will be representing.

Both horse and rider must be present for a minimum of 4 hours at a working rally to qualify as a horse and rider combination. Attendance Qualifications must be fully gained prior to the close of entries for any state championship.

The dates on which Associate members attend their own pony club rallies to help and coach, may be recorded as rallies attended, provided that the qualifying mount is known to the club instructor and/or the Zone Chief Instructor to be competent at Pony Club activities.”

At Wamboin, attendance records are maintained by our Senior Instructor, Robyn Slater. Riders can also independently retain an attendance record by using a rally day attendance card. These are available from our Secretary, Jeni Worden, and **must be signed by an instructor at each rally day attended**. This method is recommended for riders who plan on riding at state events, as this allows for easy photocopying of your rally day attendance to send in with your state championship nominations, which must be signed by both Robyn and Jeni. In Zone 16, the Zone Rally days (next one is 19 June) count for the purposes of rally day attendance under this rule.
