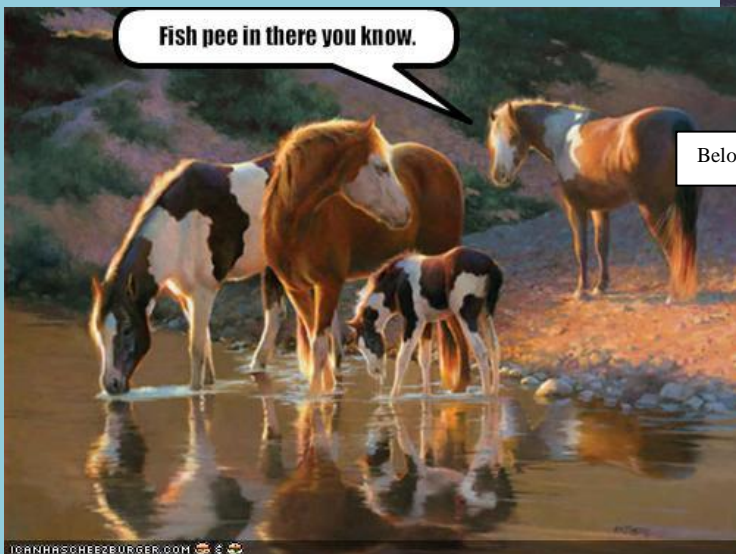
### WPC/GGPC Challenge

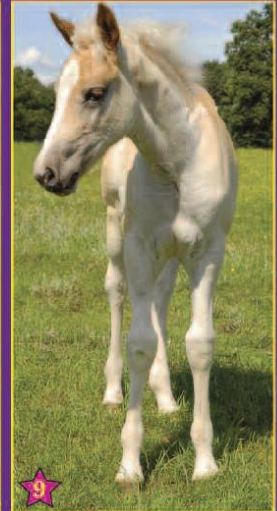
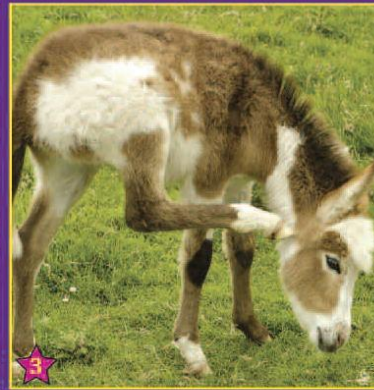
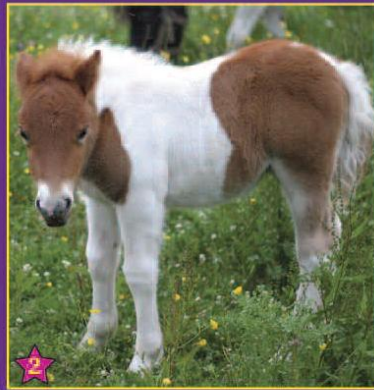

# Ally & Penny at National MG

The PCA Australia Prince Phillip Mounted Games Championships were recently held (Saturday the 8th of September) in South Australia.

Wamboin members Penny Slater and Ally Durr were in the NSW team that competed there. The team flew to SA on the Thursday before the competition where they met the teams from the other states and territories. They travelled around some of the more popular parts of Adelaide (they also went to the Royal Adelaide Show), and then competed on the Saturday.

The teams competed in 21 races, and all riders were required to ride borrowed horses.

Every three races the teams swapped to a new set of 5 horses (called a bracket). This meant that by the end of the competition every team had ridden every single horse.

The team rode well, but Western Australia and Victoria, were just that little bit better.

However given that it was Ally, Chris, Jayden & Mitch's first PCAA Mounted Games Championships they did very well. The final placings were;

W.A 1st, Victoria 2nd, NSW 3rd, 4th S.A, 5th Tasmania, 6th QLD, 7th NT.
